The Finger Lakes region of New York comes alive with fall colors each autumn. Come explore the changing leaves as you take in some of the most beautiful sights the eastern U.S. has to offer. The natural beauty of Letchworth State Park follows the course of the Genesee River as it flows north through a deep gorge and over several large waterfalls. Visit 3 fascinating museums - the Strong Museum of Play, The National Women's Rights Museum and the Corning Glass Museum along the way. A sightseeing cruise on Seneca Lake completes this fall adventure.

DAY 1: Middleburg Heights, OH - Rochester, NY

We board our motor coach early this morning and depart for our journey into upstate New York. Our first stop will be at Letchworth State Park. Renowned as the "Grand Canyon of the East", Letchworth is one of the most scenically magnificent areas in the eastern U.S. The Genesee River roars through the gorge over three major waterfalls, between cliffs as high as 600 feet in some places, surrounded by lush forests. We will visit all three waterfalls as well as the Letchworth Museum and Nature Center. Afterwards, enjoy a lunch at the

historic Glen Iris Inn. We continue our journey into Rochester, New York for an overnight stay. Dinner is included this evening at a local favorite. **L, D**

DAY 2: Seneca Falls, NY

After breakfast, we will visit the Strong Museum of Play - a highly interactive, collections-based museum devoted to the history and exploration of play. Enjoy lunch on your own at the museum before we depart for Seneca Falls and the Women's Rights National Historical Park. Afterwards, we check into our hotel for the night and enjoy an included dinner at a local establishment. **B, D**

DAY 3: Bully Hill Winery & Seneca Lake

Enjoy your breakfast this morning before we depart and return to Women's Rights National Park to explore more. Next, we traverse Seneca Lake and Keuka Lake making our way to Bully Hill Winery. Enjoy a guided tour and an

included lunch. Afterwards we make our way into Watkins Glen for the evening. Enjoy a 2.5-hour dinner cruise on Seneca Lake. Take in views only seen from the water while enjoying a delicious dinner. Later, we check into our hotel for our final overnight. **B, L, D**

DAY 4: Corning, NY - Middleburg Heights, OH

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel while your bags are loaded onto the coach. We travel a short distance to Corning, New York and a visit to the Corning Museum of Glass. Here you will enjoy a guided tour along with free time to explore and shop. The Corning Museum is a fascinating place containing a collection of glass works from ancient times to modern times. Enjoy lunch on your own in the cafeteria before we board our motor coach and start the journey back to Ohio. We arrive back in Middleburg Heights later this evening with many fond memories of our Finger Lakes adventure. **B**
